Museum Research Intern is tasked with providing in-depth research and organizational support for collections and exhibition development history of scientists and entrepreneurs who manufacture vision devices that include eyeglasses, contact lenses, prescription lenses, instruments, refracting and reflecting telescopes.

The Museum Research Intern, under the direction of the CSSO (California State Society for Opticians) Board will work independently and collaboratively to collect research for the future World of Optics Museum.

Exercises judgement and independent discretion while conducting online and in-person archival research with local, national, and international repositories to provide a recommendation to the CSSO Board.
